## ACTION ITEMS

### NAI REGISTRATIONS

HALOPURE BACTERIOSTATIC WATER CARTRIDGE, (bromine), (HaloSource, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 72083-5) to control non-public health bacteria within drinking water devices. **(RM)**

HTH WINTERIZING ALGAE CONTROL, (zinc sulfate monohydrate), (Arch Chemicals, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 1258-1328) to control algae in swimming pools. **(RM)**

MAGUS MITICIDE, (fenazaquin), (Gowan Company, EPA Reg. No. 10163-297) for control of mites and whiteflies on ornamental plants, Christmas tree plantations, non-bearing tree fruits and nuts, and established ornamental landscape plantings. **(WH)**

SLN REGISTRATIONS

STINGER HERBICIDE (clopyralid), (Dow AgroSciences, EPA Reg. No. 62719-73) for control of postemergence broadleaf weed control in annual strawberries. (AS)

**REGISTRATION ACTIONS ON PENDING ITEMS**

NAI REGISTRATIONS

COMPOUND DRC-1339 CONCENTRATE – FEEDLOTS, (Starlicide, 3-chloro-p-toluidine hydrochloride), (USDA APHIS, EPA Reg. No. 56228-10) a slow acting avicide which kills certain listed target bird species in beef and dairy cattle, swine, or poultry feedlots. This product was registered effective **August 9, 2010** after receipt of information from the registrant in response to a request from the Bureau of Agricultural Environmental Laboratories for clarification of the certificate of analysis for the analytical standard provided for this product. (GT)

REFLEX HERBICIDE (fomesafen), (Syngenta Crop Protection, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 100-993) for control of broadleaf weed grasses and sedges in cotton, dry beans, snap beans and soybeans. This product was registered conditionally effective **July 15, 2010**. (AS)

VACCIPLANT, (laminarin), (Laboratoires Goemar S.A., EPA Reg. No. 83941-2) to control diseases on food crops. This product was registered effective **August 17, 2010** after receipt of written comments from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. (RM)

SNU REGISTRATIONS

ACRAMITE 50 WS, (bifenazate), (Chemtura Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 400-503) for control of certain mite species on Crop Subgroups 6A and 6B, including succulent beans, shelled soybeans and peas. This product was registered conditionally on **August 13, 2010** after U.S. EPA clarification of a label statement. (GT)

**REGISTRATION ACTIONS ON PENDING ITEMS (CONT'D)**

SNU REGISTRATIONS

RIMON 0.83 EC, (novaluron), (Chemtura Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 66222-35-400) for control of foliage/fruit chewing, sucking, and rasping insects on beans, berries (low growing), bushberries, stone fruits, cucurbit and fruiting vegetables. Upon final approval from FDEP, this product was registered effective **July 27, 2010. (WH)**

**PENDING BUSINESS**

APHIS SPINOSAD FRUIT FLY BAIT, (spinosad), (**SLN**) (USDA APHIS, EPA SLN No. FL-080008) amended SLN label providing for a reduced reapplication interval and an increase in the amount of product that can be applied for certain targeted ground applications in regulated areas under quarantine. Awaiting a response from USDA APHIS to label revisions resulting from Committee members' label reviews. (**GT**)

BELAY 50 WDG INSECTICIDE, (clothianidin), (**SNU**) (Valent U.S.A. Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 59639-152) for control of sucking and chewing insects infesting fruiting vegetables (including cucurbits) and leafy vegetables (including brassica vegetables). Residue studies and analytical standards were received by FDACS. Registrant provided updated groundwater and adjuvant label mixing information along with a draft revised label, which were accepted by FDEP and FDACS. Registrant is in the process of providing final printed label for registration. (**WH**)

BELAY INSECTICIDE, (clothianidin), (**SLN**) (Valent U.S.A. Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 59639-150, SLN FL-100005) for control of Asian Citrus Psyllid (and other pests) on non-bearing citrus trees. Awaiting receipt of FFWCC comments, along with registrant responses to ground water label observations and clarification of "seasonal or yearly" applications.

DUAL MAGNUM, (s-metolachlor), (**SLN**) (Syngenta Crop Protection Inc., EPA Reg. No. 100-816, SLN FL-100003) for use in tomatoes with a reduced Pre-Harvest Interval (PHI) from 90 days to 60 days. Awaiting a response from a registrant for label revisions resulting from Committee members' label reviews and for a laboratory method for analyzing s-metolachlor alone. (**AS**)

**PENDING BUSINESS (CONT'D)**

DUPONT ALTRISSET TERMITICIDE, (SNU) (chlorantraniliprole), (E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company Inc., EPA Reg. No. 352-829) for use by individuals/firms licensed or registered by the State to apply termiticide products. Awaiting the registrant's response to proposed revisions in the text of the label. (CC)

FOLICUR 3.6 FOLIAR FUNGICIDE, (tebuconazole), (SNU) (Bayer CropScience, EPA Reg. No. 264-752) for use on food crops such as beans, corn, cucurbits, and leafy brassica greens. Awaiting information regarding effects on bees. (RM)

IMPACT HERBICIDE, (topramezone), (NAI) (AMVAC Chemical Corporation, EPA Reg. No. 5481-524) for postemergence weed control in field corn (grown for grain, silage or seed) popcorn and sweet corn. Awaiting a response from the registrant on label discrepancies. (CC)

MERIT 2F INSECTICIDE, (imidacloprid), (SLN) (Bayer CropScience LP, EPA Reg. No. 432-1312) to control Asian Citrus Psyllid in citrus. DACS received the December 1, 2008 IFAS review, which noted the lack of site specific Florida efficacy data for the product by reviewers. The review was provided to the registrant, and they are in the process of compiling the lacking efficacy data for re-submission to IFAS. The label clarification was resolved at an interim meeting with FFWCC. (WH)

OF COURSE, (rhamnolipid biosurfactant), (NAI) (Jeneil Biosurfactant Co., EPA Reg. No. 72431-1) to control fungi on turf grass. Awaiting a response from the registrant to the Committee members' labeling questions. (RM)

PORTAL® MITICIDE/INSECTICIDE (fenpyroximate), (SNU) (Nichino America, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 71711-19) for aerial application on citrus and ground application on fruiting vegetables, melons and 'low-growing' berries. Awaiting clarification of label statements on the supplemental labeling for aerial application to citrus. (GT)

QUADRIS TOP FUNGICIDE, (azoxystrobin and difenoconazole), (SNU) (Syngenta Crop Protection, Inc., EPA Reg. No. 100-1313) to control diseases on new crops including citrus, cucurbits, brassicas, and other food crops. Awaiting revised label correcting the Environmental Hazards text on the label. (RM)
